Retiring president John Roughan reviewed the season highlighting several improvements to the club: reconstruction of Courts 1 and 2, with the assistance of the **ASB Community Trust**, the volley board concrete court and astrograss and new retaining wall at Courts 5 and 6, both on a grant from the **Southern Trust**. Thanks to **Midweek Ladies** the club also has new courtside seats, a new awning at the kitchen window and a sliding side window.

John thanked retiring **Club Captain, Ken Grant**, for his dedicated work over many seasons, **Tiina Macey**, retiring from the committee, and **Warren** and **Kyle August**, the club's popular young assistant coaches, who are going abroad on tennis scholarships shortly.

Treasurer Rob Armstrong presented the annual accounts, audited by Greg Wright. The club ended the financial year with a \$9,069 cash deficit on income of \$169,850 after putting aside \$25,813 for depreciation. Rob pointed out the income included \$65,560 in sponsorships. Subscription income was down owing to a decline in membership last year, which the courts renewal should help to rebuild.

Subscriptions were set for 2008-09 at the same level as last season.

**Life membership was awarded to Mike Tritt** in recognition of his constant and numerous voluntary work for the club over many years.

Honorariums in the form of free membership for the season were approved for the offices of Treasurer, Membership Secretary, Midweek Ladies' convenor and Juniors' Convenor, in view of the time those tasks require.

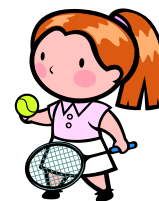
# CBTC Junior Tennis
